1	<p>In the Bid Security/EMD, it is mentioned that we can either submit EMD of Rs. 3 Lacs for E-Nose and Rs. 2.5 Lacs for E-Tongue in the form of BG/FDR/DD or we can submit Bid Securing Declaration. Can you please clarify if we submit Bid Securing Declaration, there is no need to submit EMD of Rs. 3 Lacs for E-Nose and Rs. 2.5 Lacs for E-Tongue in the form of BG/FDR/DD and bid securing declaration is sufficient? We also MSME certificate for EMD exemption.</p>	<p>If Bid Securing Declaration is submitted then there is no need to submit EMD/Bid Security. MSME Certificate is applicable only for the goods manufactured by the bidder.</p>
2	<p>We, MT Enterprises, are the Authorized Indian Dealers/representative/Distributor of Alpha MOS, France who are the manufacturers of Electronic Nose and Electronic Tongue. We will be submitting the Tender for both Electronic Nose and Electronic Tongue on behalf of Alpha MOS. So, we will be the bidder for this tender. Can you please clarify whether the Bid Securing Declaration will be submitted by us(Bidder) or Alpha MOS(manufacturer)? We believe we(MT Enterprises) have to submit the Bid Securing Declaration but we need your clarification.</p>	<p>Yes, an Indian Agent can submit the Bid Securing Declaration as per the format provided in the tender.</p>
3	<p>In the tender details document, it is mentioned that the following documents are to be submitted in the technical cover: Manufacturer Authorization form, Bid Security (EMD) or Bid Securing Declaration, Technical Bid including Technical Brochure/Literature evidencing compliance to tender specification, Compliance statement as per the format provided in the standard tender document, User List with contact details and copies of 2 POs of similar equipment supplied to other institutes, Annexure 13 and in</p>	<p>In addition to the documents sought in the cover 1, the technical bid should contain all the applicable documents as per the tender terms of the Standard Tender Document hosted on the CSIR-CFTRI website and the formats provided in it.</p>

	financial bid only BOQ has to be submitted. Can you let us know if we need to submit any other documents? If yes, please list those documents also.	
4	Please let us know whether CFTRI will be ordering to us on FCA or CIP INCOTERMS. Please also clarify whether CFTRI itself will clear the consignment through its appointed custom clearing agent and will pay custom duty and take the Instruments from Bangalore Airport to CFTRI, Mysore or MT Enterprises will have to take the responsibility of custom clearance. We would prefer if CFTRI does the same but if MT Enterprises is asked to do the same then we will appoint our custom clearance agent and ask all the requirements documents and funds for the same from CFTRI like DSIR Certificate, residual custom duty(5.5%), custom clearance charges etc.	The delivery terms like FCA or CIP shall be decided later upon the opening of financial bid (BOQ). Bidder must quote both prices in the respective columns provided in the BOQ. Customs Clearance shall be taken care by CSIR-CFTRI. H.S. Code (Customs Tariff Code) of the equipment must be indicated in the field provided in the BOQ for ascertaining customs duty.
5	In the tender document, it has been mentioned that the bidder has to quote AMC and CAMC charges for three years after warranty period. However, we are not sure where we have to quote these charges as BOQ does not have any heading for the same and we can't quote prices in the technical bid. Please clarify.	Post warranty AMC & CAMC charges as asked in the tender should be quoted in the technical bid itself. These charges will not be considered for financial evaluation of the bid. Additional Clarification sought during PBC: AMC: Shall be exclusively for services (labour) CAMC: Includes all those services and terms which is covered under warranty including spare parts.
